## **SUAC COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL**

- **As per NSW Government regulation, all archers must be double vaccinated and if not, must provide a medical exemption. Those who are not double vaccinated are not allowed to be on the range. Archers must provide proof of double vaccination, or a medical exemption when they first visit the range after lockdown.**
- **Archers MUST sign in and out using the NSW service app. If they cannot they must sign in using the backup form, this is our only way of contact tracing. A member will be assigned as a temporary COVID officer to keep track of this.**
- **People displaying any COVID-19 symptoms or who otherwise feel ill are not allowed to be on the range under any circumstances.**
- **Specific shooting, standing and resting zones will be created on the field.**
- **Archers are strongly recommended to wear a mask when not on the shooting line.**
- **Lanes are 4m wide, with a maximum of 2 archers per lane. Maintain 1.5m social distancing at all times.**
- **No sharing of equipment, no touching other's equipment (collecting other's arrows, stringing other people's bows, do not touch newbie's equipment when teaching them etc.)**
- **All equipment and trailer are to be disinfected with a spray sanitiser and wiped down with disinfecting wipes before and after use. High touch surfaces will also be frequently disinfected. Hand sanitiser to be available at all times and placed around multiple high touch areas.**
- **Any archers who wish to shoot at the field must book on the SUAC website with a maximum of 20 archers on the field.**
